2015 Annual Meeting—a Great Success!




Members and employees alike showed up in great numbers as we celebrated the life of WinSouth Credit Union on May 19 at the Gadsden Convention Hall.

Referrals from WinSouth Credit Union's branch employees are key to WFS' success, Houston says, and such generosity is rare in the financial services field.

"That's sort of our lifeblood," he says. "They send people to me or give my name to someone and tell them they need to talk to me. That's something you don't have in most positions in this industry."

An employee of WinSouth since 2007, Houston most enjoys guiding clients through the insurance and investment process. It took him three years at the start of his career to earn credentials as both a chartered life underwriter and chartered financial consultant, a personal investment he feels has paid off in spades.

"I get the most satisfaction from helping folks plan and presenting options while guiding them through the myriad products to determine which are most suitable for them and match up with their goals and objectives," he says.

4 Must-Do Steps to Protect Your Cell Phone

If your phone has ever been lost or stolen, you know the feeling of panic. It can be a nightmare—especially if you rely on your phone every day! You might also worry about your personal information and contacts falling into the wrong hands. What can you do to protect your phone? Follow these tips to keep your lifeline safe.

1. Keep your eye on it. When you head out the door, keep your phone in your purse, pocket or line of sight. Phones are a hot item to steal, so don't risk it.

2. Password-protect your keypad.

Use the lock feature on your phone to prevent it from being used even if it is lost or stolen. Your phone may be gone, but at least no one else can use it. This also prevents thieves from accessing your contact list, texts or emails.

3. Don't forget your voice mail. Sure it's nice to access voice mail with one key, but do you want anyone else listening to your messages? Use the password function on voice mail, change it regularly and keep it private.

4. Research apps before downloading. Some apps may be free to download, but charge you fees later. Read app reviews closely and pay attention to negative ones. Fake reviews are easy to write so even if most reviews are good, take the negative ones seriously.

IRA DISTRIBUTION



(Form 2317)

Payments from your IRA are subject to federal income tax withholding, unless you elect no withholding. You may change your withholding election at any time prior to your receipt of a payment. To change your withholding election, complete the appropriate form provided by WinSouth Credit Union.

Withholding from IRA payments, when combined with other withholding, MAY relieve you from payment of estimated income taxes. However, your withholding election does not affect the amount of income tax you pay. You may incur penalties under the estimated tax rules if your withholding and estimated tax payments are insufficient.


